Main Point

In our second look at Ephesians 3:1-13, we explore the great mystery of the gospel, something Paul briefly mentioned in chapter 1 (1:9, 17-20). It was God's plan to reveal this mystery during the early days of the church through the apostles, and though we may not fully realize the radical nature of this amazing revelation to the original readers, God still intends to ignite a fresh understanding of, and gratitude for, "the unsearchable riches of Christ".
