# **Support Scripture**

#### **Main Point**

James articulates a series of about a dozen tests and evidences of Christian maturity, and issues more than 4 dozen imperatives - commands and prohibitions - needed to move toward that maturity. He closes with the high calling to followers of Jesus Christ to be agents of restoration to brothers and sisters who are in sin.

### **Self Reflection/Other Direction:**

To consider: "This exhortation is of a piece with the recurring New Testament theme. That evil is not overcome merely by refraining from doing it: we are to overcome evil with good. It is not enough to break a bad habit; it is essential to love Jesus more, to want eternal things more. It is not enough to retaliate against an enemy; it is essential to love one's enemy. So too, here at the end of James' epistle: it is not enough to try to be faithful ourselves: rather, it is essential to try to secure the faithfulness of others. We overcome evil with good."
