# **Today's Main Scripture**

Malachi 4:1-6

## **Support Scripture**

Luke 1:5-25, 57-80; Gal 4:4

### **Main Point**

As we continue our hymn study exploring, *Hark! The Herald Angels Sing*, we turn our eyes to the Book of Malachi. The silence between Malachi's last words in the Old Testament and the cries of a baby in the New Testament must have caused many to doubt the promises of God. Yet God is never late, and His silence never means absence.
