1 Samuel 3:1-18

Main Point

As the under-shepherd of the Lord's flock at Perry Hall, some things have been impressed upon my heart to share with you as we start this new calendar year. Today, we will examine Samuel's call to be God's prophet, paying particular attention to his heart to ***listen and obey***, and we'll look at what this means for each one of us.

3. Prepared to Obey!
