Titus 1:5-9

Main Point

In today's passage, Paul instructs Titus to set in order the proper and necessary foundations for healthy churches. First order of business, appoint elders who will establish a biblical blueprint for healthy Christ followers. As we zoom out on Paul's teaching, we see how the principles that he outlines to lead a godly life apply to all of us who proclaim the name of Christ.

- Living Above Reproach
- Living with Self-Control
- Living as a Disciplined Believer

- 2) Define in your own words what it means to live “above reproach”. Would your life be characterized by family, friends, coworkers, teammates, etc. as one that is above reproach? If you were accused of wrongdoing, would the response of the group(s) above be shocked by the accusation or assume it is true?
- 3) What are the areas of remaining sin in your life where you need to better exercise self control? How might you remove the temptation from your life? What guardrails does our church have in place to come alongside any believer who needs help?
- 4) Examine your private life. Are you regularly studying God’s word, seeking His guidance through prayer, and fellowshiping with other believers to help in your walk as a disciplined Christ follower?
