# PROJECT 400 VISION & MISSION


## VISION

First Fruits Farm donates 100% of the food they grow to feed the hungry. We will be part of a much larger volunteer team to help plant and harvest over 2 million pounds of produce each year.

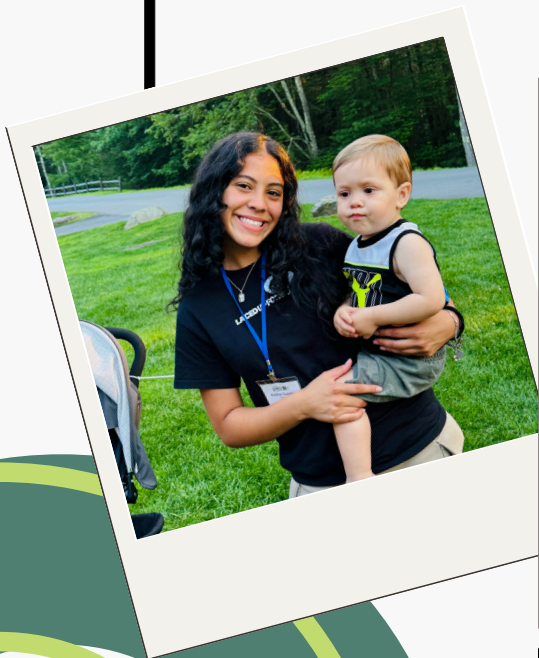
# YOUNGLIVES

This team serves the community through creating blankets, sewing Heart and Port Pillows, making Mom Survival Packs, and more.

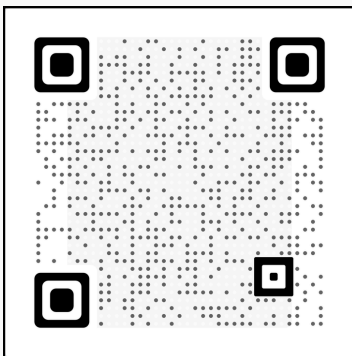
This ministry has supported breast cancer, NICU/Pediatric departments, and foster families. No prior skills necessary. This team meets once or twice a quarter.
