Main Point

As we come to the end of our short journey through the book of Titus, Paul gives some final instructions, greetings, and a final word on good works. Our primary focus, however, will be on the important applications from this short pastoral letter to the church in the 21st century – to His Church at Perry Hall.

Notes:

Self Reflection:

- 1) In chapters 2 & 3 Paul makes it clear that good works (gospel living) cannot be separated from gospel truth. How would you explain to an unchurched person the relationship of works and grace? Pray about an opportunity to start a gospel conversation.
- 2) Paul mentions several people in his closing words to Titus – clearly these folks are friends and co-workers. Who are the most trustworthy and influential people in your life, and what impact have they made in your walk with Christ?
- 3) In this short passage (vs. 8-15) Paul uses the phrase “devote themselves to good works”. Combine this with the exhortations to be “zealous for good works (2:14) and “to be ready for every good work” (3:1), and we see a strong theme emerge from Paul. What does this look like at street level?
