Exodus 20:1-17; Matthew 5:17; Luke 18:18-30

Main Point

In this final message on the Ten Commandments, we turn our attention to Jesus, specifically His handling of the Law, His clear emphasis on the importance and relevancy of the Law to the church today, and His perfect fulfillment of each of the ten words.
